- Monday
  - Bible passage: Numbers 20:1-12
  - *Prayer for My Children* – Dear Lord, there are days when we/I feel dried up like Your people in the desert. Give us/me strength during those times to continue faithfully parenting our/my child(ren). Hear our/my prayer for Jesus' sake. Amen.
- Tuesday
  - Bible passage: Numbers 27:12-23
  - *Prayer for My Children* – Heavenly Father, our/my child(ren) will have times of discouragement. Use us/me to give them/him/her hope and encouragement that they/he/she may continue to grow in Your love; in Jesus' holy name. Amen.
- Wednesday
  - Bible passage: Matthew 3:1-6
  - *Prayer for My Children* – Gracious God, Your love is like cool water in a desert land. As You refresh us/me with Your grace, so too may we/I lead our/my child(ren) to the living waters of Your unfailing love; in Jesus' name. Amen.
- Thursday
  - Bible passage: Joshua 14:1-5; 15:1
  - *Prayer for My Children* – Lord above, some days we/I feel alone and deserted as we/I strive to raise our/my child(ren) according to Your Word. Remind us/me of Your presence that we/I may always point our/my child(ren) to You; in Christ Jesus. Amen.
- Friday
  - Bible passage: Matthew 4:1-11
  - *Prayer for My Children* – Blessed Lord, at times the world will give our/my child(ren) advice that is as futile as an empty well in the desert. May we/I always be instruments to guide them/him/her through Your holy Word and Spirit. Amen.
- Saturday
  - Bible passage: Hebrews 3:7-14
  - *Prayer for My Children* – O God, each week brings times of joy and moments of sorrow for us/me and our/my child(ren). Give us/me wisdom to help them/him/her praise You for every joy and turn to You for comfort and guidance in every sorrow. Hear our/my prayer for His sake. Amen.
